

Report of CHCMI Meeting of Silampur I & II GP under Kaliachak-I Development Block on 27/09/2014

On 27/09/2014, a team of DPO-ICDS, Malda, BDO, Kaliachak-I Block, Malda, CMOH, Malda, BMOH, Kaliachak-I Block, Malda & CDPO, Sadar Sub-divison, Malda has visited Silampur I & II GP under Kaliachak-I Development Block, Malda to attend Community Health Care Management Initiative (**CHCMI**) meetings popularly known as 4th Saturday Meeting. The outcome of the meetings is given below.

Salimpur – II GP (Time: 11:30AM to 1:20PM)



There are 3 Health Sub Centres under Salimpur-II GP namely Silampur, Miyapara and Kaltipur. The point-wise details are given below.

Salient points:

- Centre No. 64 at Khaltipur Primary School has a total strength of SNP Beneficiary 206 among which 192 is child and 14 pregnant women. But the targeted SNP Beneficiary of the same centre should be less than 100 only. At present the total number of malnourished children in this centre is 9. There is a demand to establish a new ICDS centre to reach all the beneficiaries.
- The Medical Officer of the Concerned GP was not present in the meeting.
- Excessive rate of deliveries at home (almost 50%) is in Churilya under Silampur Sub Centre.
- In case of one delivery at home under Miyapara Sub Centre, a family cannot be convinced for institutional delivery. Pradhan and Sanchalak Janasasthya will look into the matter in future cases.

Salimpur – I GP (Time: 1:45PM to 3:10PM)



There are 2 Health Sub Centres under Salimpur-I GP namely Bahadurpur and Raypur. The point-wise details are given below.

Salient Points:

- In one home delivery case at Krishnapur Gram under Raypur Health Sub-Centre there was an allegation that Kaliachak Hospital has discharged a pregnant women stating it as a false pain. But after reaching home the delivery has been occurred.
- Almost 90% home delivery case is due to poor connectivity of the GP areas.
- In Bahadurpur Health Sub Centre there is a no voucher for 'Nischay Yaan' was left for distribution. CMOH, Malda was asked accordingly to supply the vouchers immediately.
- In ICDS centres there are also a deficit of Iron Capsules. CMOH, Malda ensured the delivery of 1000 iron capsules to the said centres.
- A allegation is there at a whole that the drivers of "Nischay Yaan" is denying to provide services unless the full voucher is handed over to them. BMOH will look into the matter.
- A health supervisor also raised a point that "ASHA" workers are less interested to encouraging people for family planning as their incentives per delivery in view. As a result the Family Planning Initiatives is under a huge risk.
